Trouble logging into the Computers Club website? We have the Solution:

Convert your OLD number to the NEW CAM number! How?

Example: Your number is 1234-001 Your new number is 0012341 - Here's how it was converted:

- Add two "0"s in front of the OLD number
- Add the next FOUR digits of your OLD number
- Add the LAST digit of your OLD number (typically a "0" or "1")
