### Tech Tips Continued -taken from our General Meeting

**How to make a PDF form fillable without copying it, filling it in and scanning it.**

1. You need to use the Microsoft Edge browser.

2. You need to have Edge set as your default PDF file reader.
  - If not, do this, in File Explorer right click ( or your secondary mouse button) with the cursor on the PDF file and select Open with then select Microsoft Edge.
3. In the menu bar at the top, you will see the text icon
4. Click on the text icon and you will get an outline of a text box.
5. Click the mouse button with the cursor at the location you want to insert the text and you will get the entry box. You can format the font color and size as desired.
6. After completing the text at that location, click at the next location for entry. The previous box will close and a new one will open.
7. After completing the form do a "Save as" in a location you can retrieve it from. If you just want to print the finished form, then select print.

### ***Trouble logging into the Computers Club website?***

#### ***We have the Solution:***

Convert your OLD number to the NEW CAM number! How?

**Example: Your number is 1234-001 Your new number is 0012341 - Here's how it was converted:**

- Add two "0"s in front of the OLD number
- Add the next FOUR digits of your OLD number
- Add the LAST digit of your OLD number  
(typically a "0" or "1")
