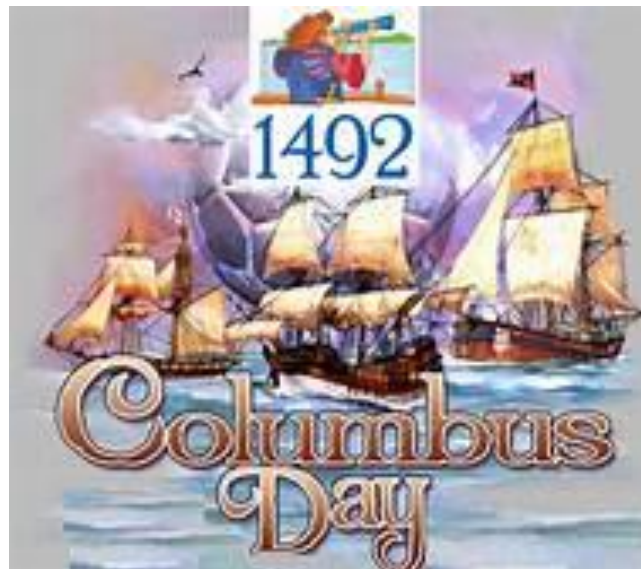

- Before you register online, please verify your Computers Club Member info. You can register for classes using any computer or device with Internet access.

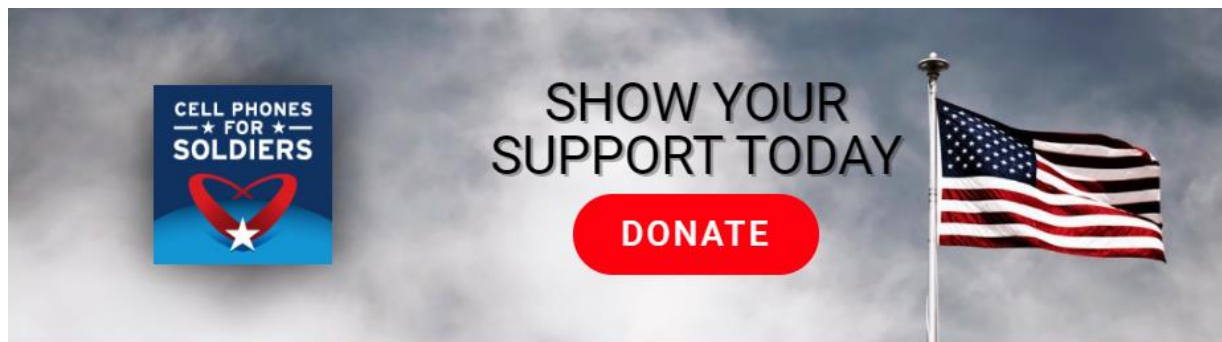
