Set a timer for the length of the activity as a reminder to turn it back on!

Ever make a mistake when texting with a "fat finger" and try to go back to the exact spot where the correction is needed? Difficult to get to the exact right spot?

Leigh Donaldson had a tip:

Tap and hold in the space bar and move to the text that needs correcting. OR tap and hold right in the texting space and do the same. On an I-Phone you can also move up or down rows this way. It's life-changing! *****
