Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

- **Step #1 – Open Photos; Click New Video>New Video Project**
- **Step #2 – Name Video; Add Your Photos and Videos**
- **Step #3 – Click 3-dots; Set Your Picture Aspect Ratio**
- **Step #4– Arrange Photos and Videos; Place in storyboard**
- **Step #5 – Edit your photos**

Using Windows 10

- **Step #6 – Editing Videos**
- **Step #7 – Click “Background Music” or check**

- **Step #8 – Synchronize video to music’s beat**
- **Step #9 – Click “Finish Video” to export and share**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #1 – Create a New Video Project

- **Open Photos**
- **Click New Video**
- **Click “New Video Project”**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #2 – Import Your Photos and Videos

- **Name your video;**
- **Add Your Photos and Videos**
- **Place in storyboard**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #3 – Set Your Picture Aspect Ratio

- **Click 3-dots in upper right**
- **Set Your Picture Aspect Ratio**
- **16:9; 4:3**
- **Set your theme from (3-dots)**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #4– Arrange Photos and Videos

- **Click and drag to arrange photos and videos**
- **Add title card**
- **Add other features**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #5 – Edit your photos

- **Limited editing functions – use another app**
- **Duration, resize, text, filters, motion, 3D effects**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app **Step #6 – Editing Videos**

- **Limited editing functions – use another app**
- **Trim, resize, text, filters, motion, 3D effects**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #7 – Import Music

- Click “Background Music” or check
- <https://www.free-stock-music.com/>
- Import from royalty free web site

Using Windows 10

**Create a slideshow using
Windows 10 Photos app.**

**Step #8 – Synchronize
Everything**

- **Can automatically sync music from built-in library**
- **Synchronize video to music's beat**
- **Manually sync music for transitions**

Using Windows 10

Create a slideshow using Windows 10 Photos app

Step #9 – Export and Share

- **Click “Finish Video” to export and share**
- **Choose from 3 possible size options**
- **Saved as mp4 format**
- **Can share to several apps**

Using Mac OS X

- **Play an instant sideshow using Photos app**
- **Create a slideshow project**

Using Mac OS X

Play an instant slideshow using Photos app

- **Limited customization**
- **Open Photos app; click “Photos” in the sidebar**
- **Select some photos; click “File” then “Play Slideshow”**

Using Mac OS X

Play an instant sideshow using Photos app

- **Click “Themes”; select theme; view preview**
- **Click “Music”; select song; click song again to turn off music**
- **Click “Play Slideshow”**
- **Press escape to stop**

Using Mac OS X

Create a slideshow project

- **Open Photos app; click "Photos" in the sidebar**
- **Select some photos**
- **Click "File">"Create">"Slideshow">"Photos"**
- **Click "Slideshow">"New Slideshow"**

Using Mac OS X

Create a slideshow project

- **Name the slideshow; click "OK"**
- **Drag and drop to reorder photos**
- **Click "Theme Picker" on right side; select theme**

Using Mac OS X

Create a slideshow project

- **Click “Music” icon on right side**
- **From drop down “Music Library”**
- **Select music from “Theme Songs” or your own**

Using Mac OS X

Create a slideshow project

- **Click “Duration” icon from right side; make changes**
- **Click “Preview” to view; click again to stop**
- **Click “Play” to view; press escape to stop**

Using Mac OS X

Create a slideshow project

- **Click "Export" in upper right**
- **Enter "Save As" name**
- **Enter "Where" location**
- **Select Format (3 sizes)**
- **Click "Save"**

Using Chrome OS

- **Create movie with Google Photos**
- **Create a show with Chrome OS Gallery**

Using Chrome OS

Create movie with Google Photos

- Open Google Photos in browser
- Select “For you” option on the left side
- Click “Movie”

Using Chrome OS

Create movie with Google Photos

- Select a movie theme
- Click "Get started"
- Select up to 50 photos and/or videos
- Click "Done"

Using Chrome OS

Create a show with Chrome OS Gallery

- Open Files app; Ctrl-click to choose photos
- Right click when done and choose "Open with Gallery" from options

Using Chrome OS

Create a show with Chrome OS Gallery

- Wait for images to appear; select rectangle with arrow pointing to the right in the upper right to display as slideshow
- Limited controls to pause, move left or right
